Overview

This report provides a comprehensive account of all damage and incidents recorded during the Brockwell Live event held in Brockwell Park. It consolidates data from the event's damage and incident logs, alongside findings from the post-event handover damage assessment. The purpose of this documentation is to ensure transparency, support accountability, and inform future event planning and park maintenance. The report outlines the nature, extent, and locations of damage sustained, categorises incidents by type and severity, and highlights any areas requiring immediate or long-term remediation. It also includes photographic evidence where available.

Damage and Incident Log

A comprehensive Damage and Incident Log was maintained throughout the Brockwell Live event to systematically record all instances of damage and incidents occurring during the build, live event, and break phases. This log served as a vital tool for monitoring the condition of the park and ensuring accountability. Each entry in the log includes the date and time of the observation, a clear description of the incident or damage, and identifies what was affected if grass, trees, or park infrastructure. It also records the specific location of the issue, a detailed description of the damage, and whether the incident was witnessed. Where applicable, the log notes if a vehicle was involved, along with a description of the vehicle if known. Finally, it captures any immediate actions taken in response. This structured approach ensures transparency, supports effective remediation, and provides a clear record for discussions with event organisers and contractors.

Hand Over Damage Assessment

A handover meeting was held following the conclusion of the Brockwell Live event, attended by representatives from the Parks Service and the Brockwell Live Team. The purpose of the meeting was to assess the condition of the site post-event, using a comprehensive visual inspection that covered the entire area. This assessment was directly compared to the baseline survey conducted on 7 May 2025, which had mapped all infrastructure, noted existing conditions, and documented any paving damage with supporting photographs. During the handover, each area of concern was reviewed against the original images to determine whether any deterioration had occurred. Observed damage was discussed in detail, and potential remedial works were identified and agreed upon where necessary.

All identified items were thoroughly recorded to enable accurate quotations for remedial works by an appointed contractor. This documentation included detailed descriptions and photographic evidence to support the scope of necessary repairs. Phase one of the grass remedial works has already been scheduled and completed at the time of writing this report, ensuring that the most immediate restoration needs have been addressed promptly. Phase two will be scheduled following the agronomist assessment in August 2025. Quotations for pavement repairs have also been obtained, and we are currently awaiting a quote from the Council's Highways contractor to undertake the pavement and drainage issues discussed during the handover.
